



PINK LAKE - Picturesque lake owes its world fame to special algae which give it a unique pink colour.

ESPERANCE WIND FARM - Due to the success of these 6 experimental electric power generators, 9 more are now operating on the coastline farther west at Ten Mile Lagoon.

GREAT OCEAN DRIVE - A 38 km scenic loop with fantastic views of rugged coastline and lakes.

BUREAU OF METEOROLOGY TOUR - Visitors welcome for a short tour and release of a weather balloon.

MERMAID LEATHER - Visit unique factory turning fish skins into leather. Tours afternoons except Mondays.

MUSEUM VILLAGE - Fascinating collection of historical buildings, housing museum and art gallery.

DEMPSTER HOMESTEAD - Built in 1867 for pioneer family, not open to public but worth viewing from street.

CYCLEWAY - Walk or cycle up to 8 km of pathway, commanding views of magnificent coastline all the way.

ROTARY LOOKOUT - Prime spot to get breathtaking views of islands, town, and rugged coastline.

ADVENTURELAND PARK - For all ages. Ride 1.2 km on a mini steam train; play indoor minigolf; hire bikes and pedal cars; use the skateboard dome; relax in parkland.

TOMMY WINDICH'S GRAVE - The Aboriginal guide and explorer who travelled with explorer John Forrest.

GOLF - Two of the State's best regional golf courses, with great views and superb grass greens.

BANDY CREEK BOAT HARBOUR - Bustling hub of south coast fishing industry and recreational boating with boat ramp and good fishing.

ESPERANCE - Major centre on south coast. Features four National Parks, majestic coastline, prime fishing and recreation. Site visited by Dutch, French and British explorers. New farming methods opened up much new land from the 1950s.

LOCAL TOURS - A variety of bus, 4WD and boat tours available to beaches, bays, national parks and the many beautiful Recherche Archipelago islands. Options include snorkelling, sandboarding, fishing, picnicking, overnight camping and accommodation. More information from Tourist Bureau.

TANKER JETTY - Nearly 1 km long, built in 1853, restored 1997 for use as recreation and fishing site.

FORESHORE/ESPLANADE - Great scenery and beaches, sailboarding, barbecues, children's playgrounds, bike path, surfcat hire.

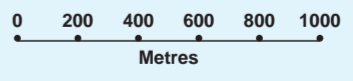
HISTORIC WALK - Brochure from Tourist Bureau will guide you on a pleasant walk around the town.
